

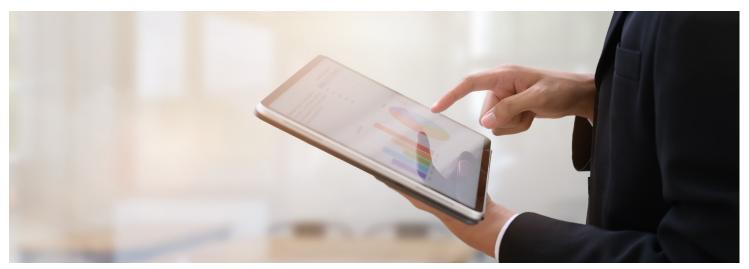
## **Creation of an E-Module Kit**

The kit is one of the five intellectual products produced by the Migrantech project partnership. It consists of a capacity building pathway for adult learners through 40 e-learning modules of 3 hours each. Based on the results of previous projects activities, the content of the 40 e-modules is currently being developed in consultation with the project partners.

On one hand, the project partners have identified the most relevant and soughtafter key, transversal and digital competences through a study conducted by the project stakeholders, namely partners from companies employing migrants and refugees, migrants and refugees who are entrepreneurs or who have found a job, as well as employment and integration professionals.

On the other hand, they have conducted a seminar to exchange good practices and are now working on the full design of these modules. Each of them responds to specific objectives such as the acquisition or improvement of language or digital skills and is designed in a pedagogical spirit with precise learning modalities including theoretical elements, advice and interactive exercises.

Therefore, the modules are aimed at both migrants and refugees in order to facilitate their access to training and employment, but also at integration professionals and educators in order to broaden their skills and the quality of their work by promoting the return or access to employment of migrants and refugees. Once the framework of each of the 40 e-modules will be completed, they will be put online on the Migrantech platform.



## Creation of a Digital Platform

The creation of the Migrantech digital platform is also one of the five intellectual productions of the project. It is an e-learning platform on which the forty e-modules designed and produced by the partners will be put online in an interactive way. It is currently being created and will provide the learning elements of the project online. The platform will host the first intellectual production of the project, namely the study on the most important transversal, key and digital competences required by companies and the world of work.



## "The toolbox"

A "toolbox" section will also be created and available for free access online. In addition to the skills required by companies and the e-modules, this section will include two infographics on the contribution of new information and communication technologies (NICT) and transversal skills to the employability of migrants and refugees, a tool for the certification of acquired skills, online counseling tools, profiling, recommendations for educators and employment professionals, elected officials and other stakeholders, case studies, videos, good practices, questionnaires for evaluation and certification of skills, an e-learning guide, a tutorial for etutors, the project report, a mapping of actors who can accompany adult learners in the partner territories and countries.



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
