1-BUSINESS LANGUAGE

3-PREPARING FOR JOB INTERVIEWS

This e-module aims at introducing learners to the job interview as a one-on-one conversation in which you and a potential employer exchange information. It provides learners with the most important components that contribute to the success of the job interview.
