As the Migrantech team, 20 participants from the 4 organizations ; AMSED, Anatolia Youth Association, Familles du Monde and Factor Social met in Izmir during 5 days to train the MIGRANTECH e-tutors.

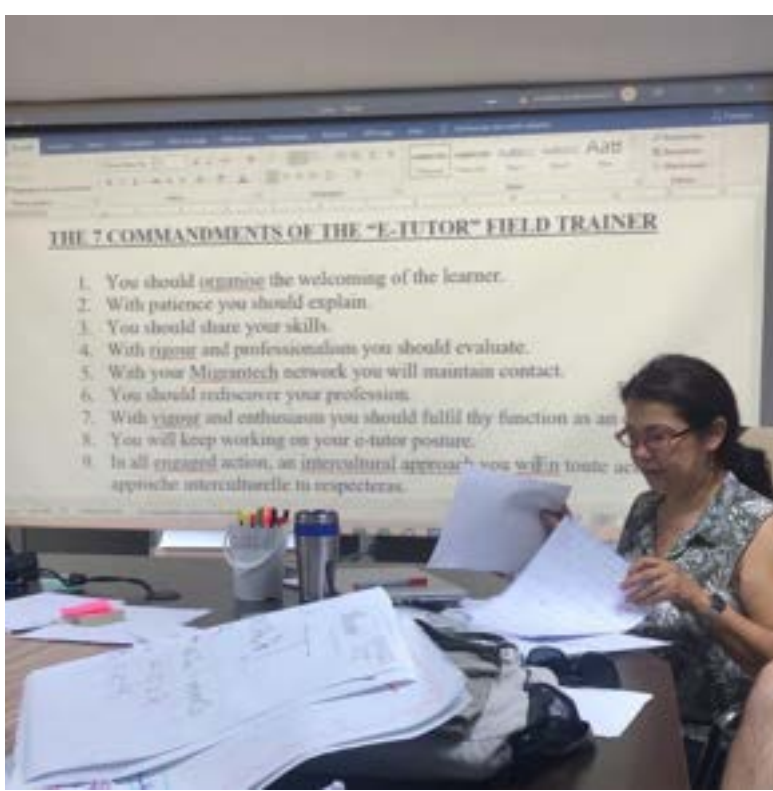
On the first day we did some ice-breakers and team building activities. Then we started to work on the project.

On the second day, we worked in groups to evaluate and improve the modules, strength and weaknesses and also technical elaboration and recommendations to improve training kit.

We participated in a reflection activity on online tutoring and did an interactive definition of e-tutoring concepts.

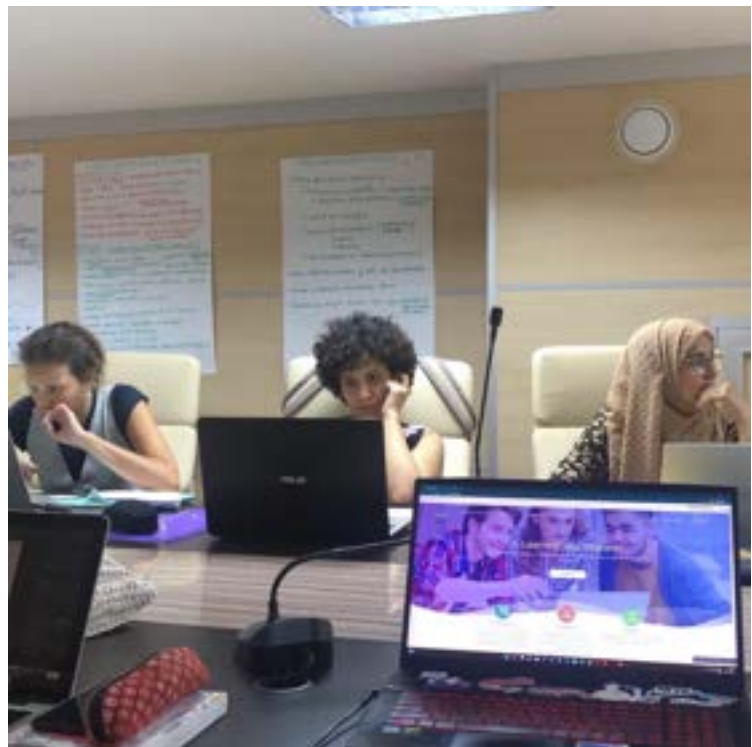
We discussed the results of the testing phase of the e-modules by migrants and refugees, and suggested some improvements.





Third day, we worked on the e-tutors competencies such as attitudes, skills and knowledge. Then, we discussed the assessment questionnaire, and the skills recognition certificate was presented and validated

On the fourth day, we prepared the program and content of the local trainings of e-tutors. Then we presented Migrantech e-learning guide. Some improvements and adjustments were added to the guide.



In the afternoon of the same day, we continued to work on the improvement of guideline and some technical and translational aspects of the platform.





On the final day, all participants from AMSED, Anatolia Youth Association, Familles du Monde, Factor Social received their certificates for attending this meeting and participating in such a busy and demanding week.
